Bag Restrictions	<p>Please be aware that there are strict conditions of entry in place for this show, particularly relating to what kind of bags you can bring into the venue.</p> <p>PERMITTED</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Clutch bags, handbags and clear plastic bags up to 30cm x 40cm ONLY <p>NOT PERMITTED</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Backpacks of any size or type ▪ Computer bags ▪ Camera bags ▪ Cooler bags of any size or type ▪ Luggage of any kind ▪ Any other bag larger than the permissible size
Bag Search & Wanding	<p>As a Condition of Entry into AAMI Park, all patrons will be subject to an increased security screening including bag searches, magnetic wanding and a ticket check process, which will be performed at all entrance points to the venue. This process will take time, so we encourage patrons to arrive close to gate opening time, be patient and limit the number of items brought to this event to alleviate queue times & avoid any disappointment. Please also review the Bag Restrictions (above) and Prohibited Items list (below) so you know what NOT to bring. Any prohibited items will not be permitted.</p>

Prohibited Items

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Backpacks of any size or type, computer or camera bags, briefcases, cooler bags of any size or type, luggage of any kind or any other bag larger than the permissible size (30cm x 40cm)
- Plastic bottles, glass, cans, aluminium, drinking containers; (empty plastic bottles, under 750ml without a lid is accepted)
- Professional cameras and any camera with a detachable lens; (Point & Shoot cameras and smartphone cameras are accepted)
- Alcohol
- Commercial food
- Illegal substances
- Audio recording devices or video cameras
- Selfie sticks, camera extensions or tripods
- Eskies, umbrellas, chairs, stools and tents
- Fireworks, flares or explosives
- Weapons or knives
- Any other objects which may be used as a missile or weapon
- Musical Instruments; air horns
- Poles, sticks, banners or oversized flags (more than A4 in size)
- Confetti or shredded paper; unauthorised advertising or flyers
- Animals (except for authorised guide dogs/companion dogs)
- Balls, sporting equipment, bicycles, skateboards, skates or scooters
- Any other object that the organiser considers inappropriate

Getting to AAMI Park

Public Transport is strongly recommended as it'll be the quickest and easiest option to get to and from AAMI Park. Trains, trams and buses operate frequently, dropping you right at the door. Tram 70 stops at AAMI Park (Stop 7D), Trams 48 and 75 stop at the MCG on Wellington Parade. AAMI Park is a five minute walk from the MCG. If arriving by Train – Flinders St, Richmond, and Jolimont Stations are all within a ten minute walk from AAMI Park.

Car Parking

Due to increased activity within the Melbourne & Olympic Parks precinct during this time, it is highly recommended patrons allow extra travel time when planning their journey. In addition to this, The Victorian Government is investing in an important project to widen the Swan Street Bridge. While the works are necessary and will improve traffic flow, there will be some disruption in the interim, with one city bound lane and one footpath on the bridge closed, so we recommend you allow extra travel time to get to and from the venue. Drivers should allow up to 20 minutes extra travel time and consider alternative travel routes. Alternative routes to the city include Alexandra Parade, Victoria Parade, Albert Street, Wellington Parade or Commercial Road. A limited number of car spots are available at Melbourne & Olympic Parks. You must pre-book your parking. You may be unable to buy parking on the day, so best to pre-book [here](#) now. Alternatively, Yarra Park (MCG Carpark) Gate 5 will be open from 4:00PM.

Drop Off / Pick Up Areas

Olympic Boulevard will be extremely busy on the event day. There are designated drop-off areas in front of Hisense Arena and the National Tennis Centre, but note that time limits apply.

Early Queuing	AAMI Park does not encourage Guests to arrive too early at the venue and queue. We know you are excited and can't wait to be here, but all too often we see Guests grow tired from waiting, become dehydrated and exhausted, and unfortunately this can lead to missing the show entirely due to illness. We recommend you arrive closer to the Gate opening time which will give you plenty of time to look at available merchandise, find which aisle you need to enter, catch up with friends, and be part of the atmosphere!
Information Desk	There are two Information Desks located on the forecourt of AAMI Park. Visit them at Ticket Sales E and F for any questions, or speak to one of our Staff Members.
Dancing	Please refrain from dancing on your seats or in aisles/stairwells. Whilst we want you to have fun, we also want you, and those around you to be safe. Feel free to dance in front of your seat (when appropriate), but please be mindful of and fair to those seated behind you.
Merchandise	Official Merchandise is available for sale during the show. There are multiple Merchandise Outlets (internal & external), and they will remain open during and after the show.
Dining & Café Options	Edwin's Café, located on the AAMI Park Front Forecourt, will be open with café service available from 7:00AM, offering food along with tea/coffee until 7:30PM. When Gates open, there are also many catering outlets located on the internal concourse selling a variety of options such as burgers, fish & chips, chicken & chips, sandwiches, snacks and ice-creams.
Tickets	The Box Office is located on the Forecourt (along Olympic Boulevard) at Ticket Sales F. If you need to collect your tickets, or have questions regarding ticketing, please speak with the Ticketek Staff who will be happy to help you. Your ticket will have all the information you need to find your seat. The Gate, Level, Aisle, Row and Seat numbers will all be printed on your ticket. You will need to scan your ticket's barcode at the turnstiles to enter the venue.
Smoking	There is strictly NO SMOKING inside the venue. Designated external smoking areas are located on the Level 1 external concourses, opposite Aisles 9 and 22. Alcohol may be taken & consumed in these areas.
ATM	There is an ATM located opposite Ticket Sales E & F (near the Melbourne Storm & Imaging @ Olympic Park offices). Additional ATMs are located inside the Stadium on the Level 1 internal concourse at Gates 2 & 7. EFTPOS and Tap&Go facilities are available at all Food & Beverage and Merchandise outlets inside the Stadium.
First Aid	First Aid posts are located on the Floor between Aisles 25-26 (in the Player's Race) & at Aisle 9. First Aid is also located on the Level 1 concourse at Aisles 1 & 21.
